Viticulture	Our culture methods are traditional and respect the ecosystem of the land where the vines are grown (the vineyard is certified iso 14001 and HVE level 3 : high environmental value). Manual harvest.
Wine Making	Total destemming and reception of the harvest by gravity, cold pre-fermentation, maceration, traditional wine making with pumping overs, plot by plot, maceration of 3 to 5 weeks, in thermoregulated stainless steel vats
Ageing	From 18 to 24 months in French oak barrels 100% new.
Blend	70% Merlot, 30% Cabernet Sauvignon
Tasting	This wine of dark color has an overwhelming nose of black fruit with a roasted touch; rich and complex, the wine impresses by its great harmony between structure, fine tannins and rich aromas.
