Tasting notes.

The color of this wine is golden with brilliant reflections.

This wine illustrates the terroirs of Sainte Croix du Mont. The

limestone soil brings to the wine a nice tension from the attack to the final highlights its freshness. The exotic fruit is blending with apricot notes and floral notes. The palate is balanced and harmonious.

The finish is delicate, marked by a touch of acidity.

Terroir

Limestone hillside on a subsoil of fossilized oysters



The vine

Average age of vines: 40 years Yeld: 30 Hl / Ha

Planting density: 5000 pieds / Ha



Vinification

Manual harvest with successive sorting (selection of botrytized grapes). Slow pressing of 4 hours. Indigenous yeast fermentation.

100% Sémillon

12,5% Vol. Aging for one year on fin e lees in concrete vats.
