**POWER TO THE HONOUR OF ELEGANCE**

*Since 1880, the Family Bertrand manage the vineyard, this is one of the latest traditional wine grower family in Saint-Emilion. After Jacques Bertrand, Anne-Marie, Bruno et Catherine grew up with all the respect and passion for the land and today they extract the best to produce a great wine.*

**THE VINEYARD** covers 16 hectares is located on the bottom of the slopes of the south-west of Saint-Emilion.

**SOILS** are Clay limestone, deep sand and gravel.

**MIDDLE AVERAGE** of the vineyard is 30 years old

**GRAPE VARIETIES** are 70 % Merlot, 30 % Cabernet Franc

**WORK METHOD** are reasoned cultural management to protect environment, Rigorous parcel selections, harvest only by hand-picked.

**HARVEST** by hand to 5 to 25<sup>th</sup> September 2022

**VINIFICATION** After two selections, one on the bunches and on one the berries, we vinified plot by plot, in temperature-controlled cement or stainless-steel vats.

**AGEING** In French oak barrels for 18 months. Barrels oak are 50% new and 50 % one wine old.

**BLENDING** and advices are undertaken jointly with J.F FORT, from the Laboratory Rolland

**PRODUCTION** : 50 Hl/Ha 45.000 bottles
