Vineyard

Château La Cardonne sits proudly on the highest plateau in the Médoc. Until 1990 the vineyard was owned and managed by Domaines Barons de Rothschild (Lafite). Since the 2000 vintage Magali Guyon (former winemaker at Lynch Bages) has been winemaker on the estate. Wines are aged underground for up to 10 years, prior to being released when they are most ready to be enjoyed. Classified Cru Bourgeois Supérieur.

48% Cabernet Sauvignon, 46% Merlot, 6% Petit Verdot - 14.1°.

Location: Médoc region, 5 miles north-west of St-Estephe.

Average vine age: 32 years.

Density of plantation: 7 500 vines per hectare.

Pruning: Guyot double.

Merlot: 20 Sep - 06 Oct. Petit Verdot: 29 Sep - 03 Oct.

Yield: 35 hectoliters per hectare.

Vinification: Each parcel fermented in separate stainless steel tanks.

50% new barrels, 49% one year old barrels, 1% amphora.
