

CHÂTEAU RAMAFORT 2022



Vineyard

Château Ramafort sits proudly on the lower slopes of the highest plateau in the Médoc. Until 1990 the vineyard was owned and managed by Domaines Barons de Rothschild (Lafite). Since the 2000 vintage Magali Guyon (former winemaker at Lynch Bages) has been winemaker on the estate. Wines are aged underground for up to 10 years, prior to being released when they are most ready to be enjoyed. Classified Cru Bourgeois.

48% Cabernet Sauvignon, 52% Merlot - 14°.

Density of plantation:	7 500 vines per hectare.

Harvest Dates:	Cabernet Sauvignon: 04 Oct - 06 Oct. Merlot: 15 Sep - 06 Oct.
Yield:	29 hectoliters per hectare.
Vinification:	Each parcel fermented in separate stainless steel tanks. 40% new barrels, 60% one year old barrels.
Analysis:	Total acidity: 3.5 g/L H2SO4 pH: 3.75 Anthocyanes: 490 mg/L IPT: 77
