From the old vineyard of the adjoining castle, built in the 12th and 14th centuries by the family of Clement V, the first Pope of Avignon, Château Roquetaillade La Grange is now owned by the Guignard family.

Terroir

Gravelly soil overlooking the Brion valley.

Grapes

60% Cabernet Sauvignon,
40% Merlot.

Average age of vines : 38 years

Planting Density : 5500 plants/ha

Yield : 38 hl/ha

VINIFICATION

Selection by densimetric sorting (Tribaie)

Maceration : 3 weeks.

Aging : a part in oak barrels and a part in cement tanks without sulfites.
