This is particularly true for the Château de Rochemorin vineyard. It is indeed the estate that suffered the most (the reds in particular) from the summer drought, due to its topographical situation and its gravelly terroir (with a sandy matrix): yields of around 30 hl/ha compared to 50 hl/ha for a normal year).

But it is also this same terroir that gives its wines a very homogeneous quality, freshness and a very good balance.

SURFACE: 53 hectares
TERROIR: Deep gravels.

GROWING METHOD: sustainable cultivation (HVE3).
